19. 25-Jul-2024 ORDERED: Staying this appeal until 08/26/2024, and revesting jurisdiction in the Maricopa County Superior court to conduct a "Faretta-like hearing" (informing appellant of the dangers and disadvantages of self-representation) and determine whether appellant's waiver of counsel on appeal is made knowingly, intelligently, and voluntarily. See Faretta v. California, 422 U.S. 806, 834-35 (1975) (identifying factors for valid waiver of counsel); Coleman, 235 Ariz. at 198-99, ¶ 19 (requiring a "Faretta-like hearing" before accepting waiver of appellate counsel). FURTHER ORDERED: Directing the clerk of the superior court to transmit to this court a certified copy of the superior court's determination regarding appellant's waiver of appellate counsel within 5 days after its entry, marked for filing in this appeal. FURTHER ORDERED: That the stay will be automatically lifted on 08/27/2024, unless one of the parties or the superior court seeks to extend the stay.
