The Apache County Attorney accuses **Joseph Douglas Roberts**, charging that in Apache County, Arizona:

Count 1 — First Degree Murder, a Class One Felony

On, about or between April 20, 2007 and April 25, 2007, **Joseph Douglas Roberts**, intending or knowing that his conduct would cause death, caused the death of William F. McCarraghe aka William F. Stone aka "Stoney" with premeditation and/or, acting alone or with one or more other persons, committed or attempted to commit burglary under A.R.S. §§ 13-1507 or 13-1508 and/or robbery under A.R.S. §§ 13-1902, 13-1903 or 13-1904, and in the course of and in furtherance of such offense or immediate flight from such offense, **Joseph Douglas Roberts** or another person caused the death of William F. McCarraghe aka William F. Stone aka "Stoney," in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1105(A)(1) and/or 13-1105(A)(2), 13-301 and 13-303.

Count 2 — Conspiracy, a Class One Felony

On, about or between April 20, 2007 and April 30, 2009 **Joseph Douglas Roberts**, with the intent to promote or aid the commission of first degree murder, agreed with one or more persons that at least one of them or another person would engage in conduct constituting first degree murder, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1003, 13-

1105(A)(1), 13-1814(A), 13-2809(A)(1), 13-2512(A), 32-1364(A), 13-2926(A) and 13-2809(A)(1).

Count 3 — Theft of a Means of Transportation, a Class Three Felony

On or about March 29, 2009, **Joseph Douglas Roberts** committed theft of Daniel Achten's 1964 Chevrolet Corvette, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-1814(A).

Count 4 — Mutilating a Human Body, a Class Four Felony

On, about or between March 1, 2009 and August 28, 2009, **Joseph Douglas Roberts**, without lawful authority, mutilated the dead human body of Daniel Achten, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 32-1364(A), 13-301 and 13-303.

Count 5 — Concealment of a Dead Body, a Class Five Felony

On, about or between March 1, 2009 and August 28, 2009, **Joseph Douglas Roberts**, knowingly moved a dead human body or parts of a human body with the intent to abandon or conceal the dead human body or parts, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-2926(A)(1), 13-301 and 13-303.

Count 6 — Tampering with Physical Evidence, a Class Six Felony

On, about or between March 1, 2009 and August 28, 2009, **Joseph Douglas Roberts**, with the intent that it be rejected or unavailable in an official proceeding which he knows is about to be instituted, destroyed, altered, concealed or removed physical evidence with the intent to impair its verity or availability, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-2809(A)(1), 13-301 and 13-303.

Count 7 — Hindering Prosecution, a Class Three Felony

On, about September 25, 2009, **Joseph Douglas Roberts**, hindered William Inmon's prosecution for the first murder of William F. McCarraghe aka William F. Stone aka "Stoney," in violation of A.R.S. § 13-2512(A).

Count 8 — Hindering Prosecution, a Class Three Felony

On, about September 25, **Joseph Douglas Roberts**, hindered James Edward Dandridge's prosecution for the first murder of William F. McCarraghe aka William F. Stone aka "Stoney," in violation of A.R.S. § 13-2512(A).

Count 9 — Hindering Prosecution, a Class Three Felony

On, about September 25, **Joseph Douglas Roberts**, hindered William Inmon's prosecution for the murder of Daniel Achten, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-2512(A).

Count 10 — Hindering Prosecution, a Class Five Felony

On, about September 25, **Joseph Douglas Roberts**, hindered William Inmon's prosecution for felony burglary and/or felony robbery, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-2512(A).

Count 11 — Hindering Prosecution, a Class Five Felony

On, about September 25, **Joseph Douglas Roberts**, hindered James Edward Dandridge's prosecution for felony burglary and/or felony robbery, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-2512(A).
