MINUTE ENTRY: STATUS CONFERENCE

LET THE RECORD SHOW this is the date and time set for a STATUS CONFERENCE in the above-captioned matter.

The Court recites the Notice filed by Gila County Attorney regarding the assignment of prosecution.

Upon inquiry by the Court, Mr. Shutts states that the Maricopa County Attorney's Office has accepted the case and gives an update on the status.

Court addresses the pending motions filed and inquires as to whether or not a file has been forwarded to the Maricopa County Attorney.

Court and Counsel discuss scheduling and time limits.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED extending time to allow responses to those motions filed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED setting this matter for a STATUS CONFERENCE for Monday, August 16, 2010 at 1:00 PM in the Apache County Superior Court. Counsel may appear telephonically.

Mr. Martin addresses his concerns regarding Rule 8 time limits, death penalty notice, and the re-assignment of the prosecutor.

The Court addresses each of Mr. Martin's concerns advising that no ruling has been made with regard death penalty notice and to the Rule 8 time limits; whether this is excluded or included time. As

previously stated, the Court is allowing the new prosecutor appropriate time to become familiar with the case and respond to the motions. Additionally, the Court clarifies the order as stated in the previous Minute Entry with regard to the re-assignment.

At the request of Mr. Shutts, he is provided with the contact information for the Apache County Attorney's Office.
