MINUTE ENTRY: Status Hearing

PRESENT IN JUVENILE COURT: Michael Whiting, County Attorney; Albert Lassen, Guardian Ad Litem; and Juvenile Probation Department.

APPEARING TELEPHONICALLY: Ronald Wood for Wood Law Office, Attorney for the Juvenile and Steve Williams for Riggs and Ellsworth, Attorney for the Mother;

LET THE RECORD SHOW this is the date and time set for a Status Hearing in the above-captioned matter.

The Court and Counsel discuss the appointment of Dr. John V. Scialli and Dr. Shelly Uram that the State has suggested and Dr. Gwen Levitt, Mr. Wood's suggestion.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appointing Dr. Scialli and Dr. Uram to perform evaluations as set forth in the Admission Agreement. The Court requests that Mr. Whiting separate the pleading of March 4 from the exhibits and file the pleading as unsealed.

The Court and Counsel discuss Mr. Lassen's request for an audio copy of the Admission Hearing and a copies of the evaluations that have been preformed. Mr. Williams would also like copies of the evaluations. The Court requires Mr. Williams to make his request in writing, with copies to Mr. Whiting, Mr. Wood and Mr. Lassen. Mr. Williams would like courtesy copies of any Motions or Notices that Mr. Wood or Mr. Whiting file.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED copies of Dr. Johnson's and Dr. Cady's reports, as redacted, be made and forwarded to Mr. Lassen in his capacity as Guardian Ad Litem with the understanding that they are thoroughly and completely restricted from secondary dissemination. They are not to be disclosed to anybody.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk make a copy of the digital recording of the Admission Hearing and forward said copy to Mr. Lassen at her convenience.

The Court and Counsel discuss granting visitation and the Court will take the matter under advisement.

The Court, Counsel and Juvenile Probation Department discuss schooling for the Juvenile. The Court asks Juvenile Probation to keep the Court, Mr. Whiting, Mr. Wood and Mr. Lassen informed on this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED setting this matter for a Status Conference on **Thursday, April 02, 2009 at 1:00 PM** in the Apache County Superior Court. Counsel may appear telephonically.

Mr. Whiting requests that Dr. Scialli, Dr. Uram and Dr. Cady be allowed to talk to one another. There is no objection.
