
Upon discussion with counsel concerning the scope of proposed services,

IT IS ORDERED appointing Betty Beaumont, M A , of FamilyFirst Counseling & Behavioral Health Services, Inc , to provide counseling and therapeutic intervention to the minor on the same basis as other contract providers of similar services

It is contemplated that frequency, scope and duration of services will continue as presently scheduled, but may be increased as therapeutically appropriate upon consultation with and agreement of management of Juvenile Probation Department, such agreement may not be unreasonably withheld
