

The Juvenile, through counsel and pursuant to Rule 23 (d) of the Rules of Procedure in Juvenile Court, Article 2 § 24 of the Arizona Constitution, the 8th and 14th Amendments to the US Constitution moves the Court to order the immediate release of the juvenile. He has been in detention since Wednesday, May 16th 2012 and has been held without either a court order or a detention hearing since that time. The Rule clearly states that if the juvenile is to be in detention, that there must be a detention hearing within 24 hours or the Juvenile gets released. Here, the probation department has violated the court orders, violated the Rules of Criminal Procedure, failed to file the appropriate pleadings with the Court.

Therefore, the Juvenile requests that he be released to either his grandmother or his mother immediately.
