MINUTE ENTRY: DISPOSITION

PRESENT: JUVENILE; PARENT/GUARDIAN OF THE JUVENILE; RON WOOD, ATTORNEY FOR THE JUVENILE; DEPUTY COUNTY ATTORNEY AND JUVENILE PROBATION DEPARTMENT.

PRESENT BY PHONE: DR. SCIALLI.

LET THE RECORD SHOW this is the date and time set for DISPOSITION in the above-captioned matter.

Court and Counsel discuss Dr. Scialli giving the Court information telephonically; Dr. Scialli is called.

Dr. Scialli is sworn and testifies.

Counsel give their Oral Arguments and recommendations.

Court and Julie Nicholson of Juvenile Probation, discuss the procedures for contacting the Therapeutic Group Homes and the turnaround time of the placement facilities. Ms. Nicholson also informs the Court of Therapeutic Foster Homes being contacted and only one requested a packet of information be sent to them.

Counsel and Defense Counsel question Julie Nicholson.

Family members are given an opportunity to address the Court.

Court addresses the Juvenile.

Court informs all parties that a final decision will not be made today.

Court would like to place on the record her appreciation to YDI for what they have provided for the Juvenile and to Dr. Lewis her deep appreciation for the work he continues to give the Juvenile.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Juvenile Probation Department look into the Group Home Placement. Court would like the TRY program and the Back to Life Program to be looked into. The Court would like the Group home to support ongoing therapy between Juvenile and Dr. Lewis, if Dr. Lewis is able to continue with that therapy, either on site or at a separate location.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the facility speak to Dr. Lewis and to Dr. Scaili in person or review their recent reports. The Court would also like the facility to know that there is a large family who wants to be involved with the child and is open to visits and day passes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED setting a POSSIBLE DISPOSITION for Wednesday, January 16, 2013 at 3:30 PM in the Apache County Superior Court. The Court requests the Probation Department provide her with all information it can.

Court and Juvenile Probation discuss transporting Juvenile back to YDI and his return on January 16, 2013.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Juvenile Probation Department will transport Juvenile for the hearing on January 16, 2013, no more than 24 hours before the hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Juvenile Probation Department may release documents as needed for the placement and current reports from the Doctors need to be included.

Court is requesting that Dr. Lewis prepare an update of Juveniles progress since his last report.

Hearing concludes.
