**MINUTE ENTRY: Status Hearing**

**PRESENT IN JUVENILE COURT:** Benjamin Brewer for Wood Law Office, Attorney for the Juvenile; Michael Whiting, County Attorney; Albert Lassen, Guardian Ad Litem; and Juvenile Probation Department.

**APPEARING TELEPHONICALLY:** Ronald Wood for Wood Law Office, Attorney for the Juvenile; and Steven Williams for the Law Ofc. of Matthew Riggs, Attorney for the Juvenile's Mother.

LET THE RECORD SHOW this is the date and time set for a Status Hearing in the above-captioned matter.

The Court and Counsel discuss the education options for the Juvenile. They have looked at all apparent possibilities and choices. There is discussion concerning the last paragraph of the Memorandum of Agreement which the Court reads into the record.

"The juvenile shall not be allowed to enroll in any public, private or charter school (or any school that is not a secured facility) until the juvenile is determined to not pose a threat to himself or the public and such determination is submitted to the Court in writing by his evaluating psychiatrist and the State and defense and victims are given an opportunity to object at a hearing before this Court."

The Court inquires of Ms. Himes, if the Juvenile reports to the Juvenile Detention Center every day, will the detention teacher be able to accommodate him. Ms. Himes states that is feasible.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Juvenile will report to the Juvenile Detention Center at 1:30 every afternoon, Monday through Friday, for educational purposes. Ms. Castillo is asked to inform Ms. Himes if the Juvenile is going to be late.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED setting this matter for a **Status Conference on Thursday, May 21, 2009 at 1:00 PM** in the Apache County Superior Court as previously ordered.
