

Mr. Whiting concurred with the Court.

Mr. Wood advised the Court Counsel has arranged a meeting with the treatment staff of the Department of Corrections as the Department of Corrections is assisting Counsel in locating treatment for the juvenile. Mr. Wood further advised the Court he will file additional Motions outlining possible treatment alternatives.

The Court directed Mr. Wood to file responsive pleadings no later than November 16, 2009 and a further hearing will be scheduled at which time the Court will issue its ruling if it is able to.

The Court scheduled a Motions Hearing on **November 18, 2009 at 3:00 p.m. to be held at the Apache County Superior Court in Saint Johns, Arizona.**

Mr. Wood advised the Court he is willing to waive the juvenile's presence for the scheduled hearing.

Counsel had no objection to waiving the presence of the juvenile and the juvenile's parent for the scheduled hearing.

The Court waives the presence of the juvenile and his mother at the forthcoming hearing. The Court further waives the presence of the juvenile and mother for all further hearings unless the presence of the juvenile and his mother is requested by Counsel or ordered by the Court.

The Court directed Counsel to send a copy of any further filed pleadings to the Navajo County Superior Court via facsimile.
