P E T I T I O N

TO THE SUPERIOR COURT OF YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA:

C. I. JACKSON, Commissioner for the Lower Verde Ditch,
and MARION E. DAVIDSON, Commissioner for the Upper Verde Ditch,
each hereby respectfully petitions this Court as follows:

That as duly appointed and qualified Commissioners
of the Upper Verde Ditch and Lower Verde Ditch, they have the
duty to manage the affairs of said ditches and to enforce the
provisions of the judgment and decree entered by Judge Richard
E. Sloan, of the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District
of the Territory of Arizona on March 23, 1909.

That pursuant to the terms of said judgment, each
user of the ditch in such proportion as set out in the judgment
must pay for the use and for the cost of repairs and maintenance
of the ditches.

That the named defendants have failed to pay for the
use of the ditches and/or have, by their course of conduct,
interfered with the maintenance and proper operation of the

ditches all to the damage of the other users of the ditches.

That unless the defendants are required to comply with said Sloan Judgment, the ditches can no longer be operated and maintained in a proper manner.

That these petitioners respectfully request that this Court cite these defendants into this Court on a day certain to show cause why their rights in the use of said ditches should not be terminated or for such other and further relief that appears legal and just in the premises.
