It being brought to the attention of the Court that a vacancy occurs in the office of Ditch Commission of District 3, Lower Verde Ditch Company; and,

It appearing to the Court that GLEN W. EVERETT was elected at a meeting held on March 9, 1974; and,

It further appearing to the Court that said meeting did not have a legal quorum; and,

It further appearing that there is a great need to fill the vacancy; and,

It further appearing that other shareholders have expressed support for GLEN EVERETT,

NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED that GLEN W. EVERETT be appointed to fill the vacancy as Commissioner of District 3, until the annual meeting of shareholders on the first Monday of October, 1974, as set forth in the Rules and Regulations of the Verde Ditch.

Dear Mr. Roer:

This letter will be your official notice that we the undersigned supervisors of the Verde Ditch Company of Camp Verde, are and will hold you, your heirs or assigns or successors, fully responsible for any and all damages whatsoever caused by any break or overflow caused by a break in any manner along the Verde irrigation canal that runs along and thru your property on the East Central part of Camp Verde. In your disregard for the north or low side of this canal you have reduced its width so that it cannot be cleaned or that a machine can travel on the canal bank for that purpose. This canal has an easement right by constant use and practice for many, many years, so it can be kept clean and in good condition by the free and open passage along either side (normally the low side of the canal) for such equipment as is necessary.

A copy of this letter has been sent to the Supervisors of Yavapai County and to the Superior Court Judge Jack L. Ogg, of Prescott, Yavapai County, Arizona.
