## MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

On March 23, 1909, the then District Court of the Fourth Judicial District of the Territory of Arizona, predecessor to the Superior Court in and for the County of Yavapai, established Commissioners of the Verde Ditch to be responsible to the court with duties of managing the affairs of the Verde Ditch. In order to help guide the Commissioners in the management of the affairs of the Verde Ditch, in 1963 Judge Jack L. Ogg promulgated Rules and Regulations for the operation of the Verde Ditch. Included in those Rules are the following sections:

- 2. The Commissioners, their agents, employees and equipment shall have the right of usage at any time of necessary work areas adjacent to the Ditch in pursuit of maintenance, repair and operation of the facility. \* \* \*
- 3. Construction or installation of gates, buildings, cross-fences, or any other obstruction over the Ditch or in the work area which may interfere with usage of the work area or Ditch is forbidden.

On August 8, 1989, to further protect the welfare and needs of the Verde Ditch and its shareholders, Richard Anderson, Yavapai County Superior Court Judge and Master of the Verde Ditch, issued an Order Promulgating New Rules and Regulations for the Operation of the Verde Ditch, which Order included the following rules:

2. The commissioners, their agents and/or employees, using appropriate equipment, shall have the right of useage at all times to the work areas adjacent to and on both sides of the ditch for the 1

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purposes of maintenance, repair, and operation of the Verde Ditch. Private property may be crossed in order to gain access to the Verde Ditch.

3. Construction or installation of gates, buildings, posts, fences, cross-fences or any other obstruction along or over the ditch or in the area adjacent to the ditch which interferes with the flow of the Verde Ditch or the ability of the Verde Ditch commissioners, agents or employees to move necessary equipment up and down the ditch and ditch banks is prohibited.

subsequent to February, about a date or dates On or 1989, Jim Davis and Colleen Davis, his wife, owners of private property located in Yavapai County adjacent to the right bank of the Verde Ditch, constructed or caused to be constructed, posts and connecting pipe approximately three (3) feet from the edge of the ditch, an iron fence down to the ditch and an electric fence running parallel to the ditch. Further, Jim Davis and Colleen Davis, his wife, have planted, or have indicated they intend to plant, young trees along the ditch bank. tion of such fences, fence posts and trees impedes and prohibits the ability of the Verde Ditch Commissioners, their employees and machinery to move freely along the Verde Ditch to maintain, repair and operate the ditch. Such obstructions are improper and without authorization, and despite requests by the VERDE DITCH COMPANY, Jim Davis and Colleen Davis, his wife, have failed refused to remove such obstructions.

Accordingly, the **VERDE DITCH COMPANY** is without adequate remedies unless the Court orders Jim Davis and Colleen Davis, his wife, to show cause why:

 An appropriate order should not be entered against them requiring them to remove the obstructions they have placed along the Verde Ditch; 

- 2. Requiring them to pay the VERDE DITCH COMPANY's attorney's fees and court costs incurred herein; and
- 3. Such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper under the circumstances should not be granted.

- 3. The Verde Ditch Company has repeatedly requested that JIM DAVIS and COLLEEN DAVIS, his wife, remove the fences, fence posts and trees they have placed and planted along the Verde Ditch, but they have failed and refused to do so.
- 4. Unless the obstructions placed along the Verde Ditch by Jim Davis and Colleen Davis, his wife, are removed, the ditch cannot be adequately maintained, repaired and operated in a proper manner.
- 5. The inability of the Verde Ditch Company to properly maintain, repair and operate the ditch existing on the Davis property will not only cause damage to the ditch and increase maintenance and repair expenses and costs, but may ultimately result in the authorized water users of the ditch being unable to receive ditch water in the future.
