The Court notes it received a Proposed Scheduling Order by Counsel James Belanger.

Counsel Joquese Blackwell informs the Court he has reviewed the Proposed Scheduling Order and he has no objection to the date outlined in the order.

Counsel Marcus Finefrock informs the Court he has also reviewed the Proposed Scheduling Order and notes the only issue is if they will have the final supplemental disclosure after they have completed the interviews.
