3 Defendant James Arthur Ray, by and through his attorneys of record, request
4 leave to exceed the page limits for his Rule 20 Motion For Judgment of Acquittal, filed with this
5 Court on June 3, 2011. The Court has discretion to grant Mr. Ray's request, Ariz. R. Crim. P.
6 35.1(b), and "[u]pon request of a party, or on its own initiative, the court may waive a
7 requirement specified in this rule, or overlook a formal defect in a motion or request." Ariz. R.
8 Crim. P. 35.4. The Rule 20 motion involves critical issues implicating Mr. Ray's constitutional
9 rights to due process of law, and addresses the myriad, complex legal and factual issues
10 developed over the course of this 16-month litigation and 4-month trial, thus requiring briefing
11 beyond the customary page limits.
