7 Appellant makes this request to pursuant to Arizona Rule of Procedure 31.8(b), as well as
8 the Sixth, Eighth, and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution and Article II of
9 the Arizona Constitution, which provisions protect a defendant's right to full review of his case
10 on appeal, his right to the assistance of counsel on appeal, and his right to equal access to the
11 courts that would review any conviction on appeal or collateral attack. *See generally, e.g.,*
12 *Draper v. Washington*, 372 U.S. 487, 499-500 (1963) (right to appellate examination "based upon
13 a sufficiently complete record of the trial proceedings"); *State v. Bay*, 150 Ariz. 112, 115 (1986)
14 (importance of complete record of trial proceedings).
