FURTHER ORDERED: That no later than 20 days from the Clerk's distribution of the Rule 31.2(e)(3) notice of right to counsel, Cameron must inform the superior court whether he wishes to request that the superior court appoint appellate counsel to represent him in this appeal. If so, then the superior court shall appoint appellate counsel, who must file a notice of appearance in this court within 10 days following the order of appointment. If, however, Cameron desires to waive his right to appellate counsel, the court shall ensure that Cameron has made a knowing, intelligent, and voluntary waiver, and provide a minute entry confirming that finding to this court no later than 40 days after the Clerk's distribution of the Rule 31.2(e)(3) notice of right to counsel. FURTHER ORDERED: Staying this appeal until this court receives record documents confirming that the superior court has (1) appointed appellate counsel for Cameron or (2) found that he has properly waived his right to counsel. FURTHER ORDERED: Directing the clerk of this court to send this order to the State, Cameron, the Honorable Rick Lambert, and the Clerk of the Mohave County Superior Court.
