REQUEST FOR INTERPRETATION
OF JUDGMENT

To the Honorable Richard Lamson, Judge of the Superior Court of the State of Arizona, in and for the County of Yavapai:

Comes now Ralph E. Monroe, and representing himself and other ranch owners on the Old and New Verde Ditches, pursuant to the authorization hereto attached, and Earl Hopper, ranch owner on the Old Verde Ditch, and respectfully petition the Court to interpret the Conclusions of Law and Judgment made and entered in this Court on the 23rd day of March, 1909, in the following respects:

1. Does the ranch owned by Earl Hopper, which is designated in said decree as the See & Reeves ranch, annually pay ^{his proportion} in work, money, or material 450/1260ths of the cost of the maintenance and repair of the New Verde Ditch and the Old Verde Ditch, or should he contribute in money, material, or labor,

1/10th of the cost of the maintenance and repair of the New Verde Ditch, plus 1/5th of the cost of the maintenance and repair of the Old Verde Ditch?

2. Shall the Lower Verde Ditch, or the Old Verde Ditch, be entitled to 450/1260ths of the water at the intake on the Verde River, measured at the intake, or shall the Old Verde Ditch (Lower Verde Ditch) stand its proportion of the seepage, leakage, and evaporation?

3. The E. J. Monroe ranch mentioned in the decree, and now owned by Frank W. Wingfield, uses 2/5ths of the water of the Old Verde Ditch. What proportion of labor, material, and money must Frank W. Wingfield pay for the maintenance, upkeep and repair of the Old Verde Ditch and of the New Verde Ditch?
