INTERPRETATION OF JUDGMENT

The request of Ralph E. Monroe and Earl Hopper for an interpretation of the judgment rendered in the above entitled matter, coming on for hearing before the Court on this 29th day of March, 1938, said petitioners appearing in person;

Thereupon the matter is discussed with the Court and submitted, and the Court makes the following decisions to the questions contained in said request:

1. That Earl Hopper should contribute one-tenth (1/10th) of the cost of the maintenance and repair of the New Verde Ditch, plus one-fifth (1/5th) of the cost of the maintenance and repair of the Old Verde Ditch.

2. The Court feels that it is not sufficiently informed as to the rights of the parties, to answer the second question.

3. Inasmuch as Frank Wingfield does use two-fifths (2/5ths) of the water delivered to the Lower Ditch, he should pay his proportion or part with his neighbors of the upkeep and repair of the Upper Ditch, which would be one-fifth (1/5th).
