ORDER ACCEPTING RESIGNATION OF WATER COMMISSIONER  
and  
ORDER APPROVING AND SETTLING ACCOUNTS

RALPH E. MONROE, Water Commissioner under the Decree of Honorable Richard E. Sloan, Judge, made and entered in the above entitled cause on the 23rd of March, 1909, having executed and filed herein his written Resignation as such Water Commissioner under appointment dated May 28th, 1935, and at the same time having rendered and filed herein an Account and Report of his stewardship as such Water Commissioner, which Account and Report was for a final settlement as of the time of his Resignation, and said Resignation and Report and Account this day coming on regularly to be heard, and proof having been made to the satisfaction of the Court that the Clerk of said Court had given notice of said written Resignation and settlement of said Account and Report in the manner and for the time required by law, the Court finds:

1. That said Account and Report upon resignation is in all respects true and correct and supported by proper vouchers and receipts; that the residue of money in the hands of the Water Commissioner, as of May 15, 1953, the time of preparation of said accounts, was the sum of Ninety-four and 44/100 Dollars (\$94.44); that Ralph E. Monroe as Water Commissioner has received no funds and has made no expenditures since May 15, 1953, the date of preparation of his final accounts and report;

2. That the books and records of the "Woods or Verde Ditch Company" are in all respects true, accurate and correct, and that the financial position of said "Woods Ditch Company", as reflected by the account and report of Ralph E. Monroe, Water Commissioner, on date of his Resignation and Account and Report, is as rendered in said Account and Report on file herein.

NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

I.

That the Account and Report of Ralph E. Monroe, Water Commissioner by appointment of this Court on the 28th day of May, 1935, under the decree of the Honorable Richard E. Sloan, Judge, made and entered in the above entitled cause on the 23rd day of March, 1909, be, and the same is hereby, confirmed, approved, allowed and settled in all respects as rendered.

II.

That all acts and things done by Ralph E. Monroe in his stewardship as Water Commissioner under the above described decree, be, and

the same are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified in all respects as rendered.

III.

That the written Resignation of Ralph E. Monroe, as such Water Commissioner under the above described decree, be, and the same is hereby accepted and ordered placed on file with the Clerk of this Court.


IV.

That Ralph E. Monroe be, and he is hereby relieved of all duties directed in order of appointment as Water Commissioner dated May 28, 1935, and that he is hereby discharged from all further liability or responsibility under order of appointment dated May 28, 1935.

V.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the books, records and accounts of the "Woods or Verde Ditch Company", heretofore maintained and kept pursuant to the authority and supervision of Ralph E. Monroe, Water Commissioner, be, and the same are hereby placed under technical custody of this Court pending appointment of successor Water Commissioner by order of this Court, and that physical possession of said books, records and accounts, under said technical custody, be, and the same is hereby, placed in the hands of Pauline Boyer, resident of Camp Verde, Arizona, Acting Secretary of the "Woods or Verde Ditch Company".
