
Based on a review of the records submitted, the Court SUSTAINS the following objections by Defendant:

- Page 47, line 23-25- after "unusual" – improper opinion
- Page 57, lines 17-23- entire answer – hearsay
- Page 80, lines 1-4- improper opinion
- Page 86, lines 10-25- after "UPS." – hearsay
- Page 100, lines 8-10 – speculation
- Page 141, lines 5-10 – leading
- Page 145, lines 11-15 – after "I think"- speculation
- Page 145-146, lines 25-6 – not relevant

As to the remaining objections, they are OVERRULED for the reasons stated in the State's Response.

IT IS ORDERED the State redact the video deposition in accordance with the Court's ruling prior to trial and mark with the Clerk's office by the first day of trial.
